Responsibilities:

Clinical

- Assesses patient and family needs, incorporating psychosocial, emotional and spiritual needs.
- Contributes to/manages daily patient care rounds.
- Performs appropriate history and physical examination
- Performs, orders and interprets results of diagnostic and laboratory tests.
- Interprets above findings in order to determine appropriate interventions.
- Formulates a therapeutic multidisciplinary plan of care based on identified needs.
- Incorporates age-specific interventions related to safety, nutrition and physical limitations.
- Provides appropriate treatments and performs procedures in accordance with established policies.
- Request appropriate consultations for assistance with patient management.
- Documents care reflective of advanced practice in the medical record in accordance with established policies. Provides patient and family educations to meet identified learning needs.
- Identifies and consults appropriate community resources to provide continuity of care at home (ie. home care and hospice agencies).
- Provides education to staff members responsible for the provision of recommended activities and interventions.
- Serves as a role model for staff members in the direct provision of care.
- Prescribes appropriate medications and/or treatments in accordance with Medical Staff bylaws, state and federal regulations.
- Evaluates the patient's response to therapy and appropriately modifies the interventions, as needed.
- Performs diagnostic and therapeutic procedures in accordance with established policies.
- Completes mandatory safety training annually

- Adheres to bodily fluid and blood precautions
- Practices within the scope of the Written Agreement as approved by the Maryland Board of Nursing

- Maintains daily rounds list
- Provides accurate and timely coding/billing documentation
- Assists the supervising physician with maintaining the medical record
